"We hope party-goers walk away from this fun Saturday night outing with new friends and new perspectives."

Now in its third year, NEXT is a program of JWT made possible with generous support from The Los Angeles Department of Cultural Affairs, The Jewish Community Foundation of Los Angeles, Erwin Rautenberg Foundation, and the Y&S Nazarian Initiative, a program of The Jewish Federation of Greater Los Angeles. Emerging writers, actors, directors and theatre professionals create their own shows and events under the mentorship of JWT's experienced professional staff.

Fromer has been a member of NEXT since the beginning and he enthusiastically embraces the opportunity it provides to his generation. "NEXT @ The Braid has completely changed my life as a working artist," Fromer explains. "I was so fortunate to land a spot on the inaugural council and from that opportunity, grow my skillset and role at JWT. I now get to have my voice as a part of JWT's long-term future and therefore play a part in shifting the cultural landscape of Jewish
